Dear Councillor McGrath and members of the South Copeland GDF Community Partnership,

I commend the South Copeland GDF Community Partnership for making your forthcoming meeting on 12 October open to the public and making time available on the agenda for questions to be asked by the public. I hope this will soon be replicated by the other three Community Partnerships.

I am writing to you as Chair of the Nuclear Free Local Authorities to urge you to go still further to make your proceedings and deliberations more transparent and accessible to the public, in accordance with the best practice established for many years in local government.

Namely:

- By asking all members of the Community Partnership to declare and record Declarations
 of Interest at the start of every meeting (particularly where members, their partners or
 family members work for, or provide goods or services in any capacity to, the nuclear
 sector or receive payment in any capacity from Nuclear Waste Services or the Nuclear
 Decommissioning Authority).
- By ensuring meeting venues are fully accessible to attendees with disabilities and equipped with a hearing loop.
- By publishing the agenda and papers for each meeting in advance on the Community Partnership website, in addition to posting the minutes and agreed actions thereafter.
- By making access to these documents easier. At present the website is hard to navigate. Rather than requiring inquirers to access the minutes via the Resources section, it would be better if you had a specific front section marked Meetings.
- By livestreaming meetings, and by making footage of meetings available afterwards, via a link on the website under the Meetings section.
- By inviting representatives of local media outlets (press, radio) to attend.
