# Methodology

## Survey methodology

Between 4 and 23 March 2024, Yonder oversaw a survey of 201 residents (16+) interviewed in person across the wards of Millom and Millom Without. The interviews were conducted by Red Research, on behalf of Yonder.

Quotas were employed to ensure the resident sample was representative of the relative populations of the two wards. Weighting was then employed to ensure the sample was representative in terms of the age and sex profile of the population in question.

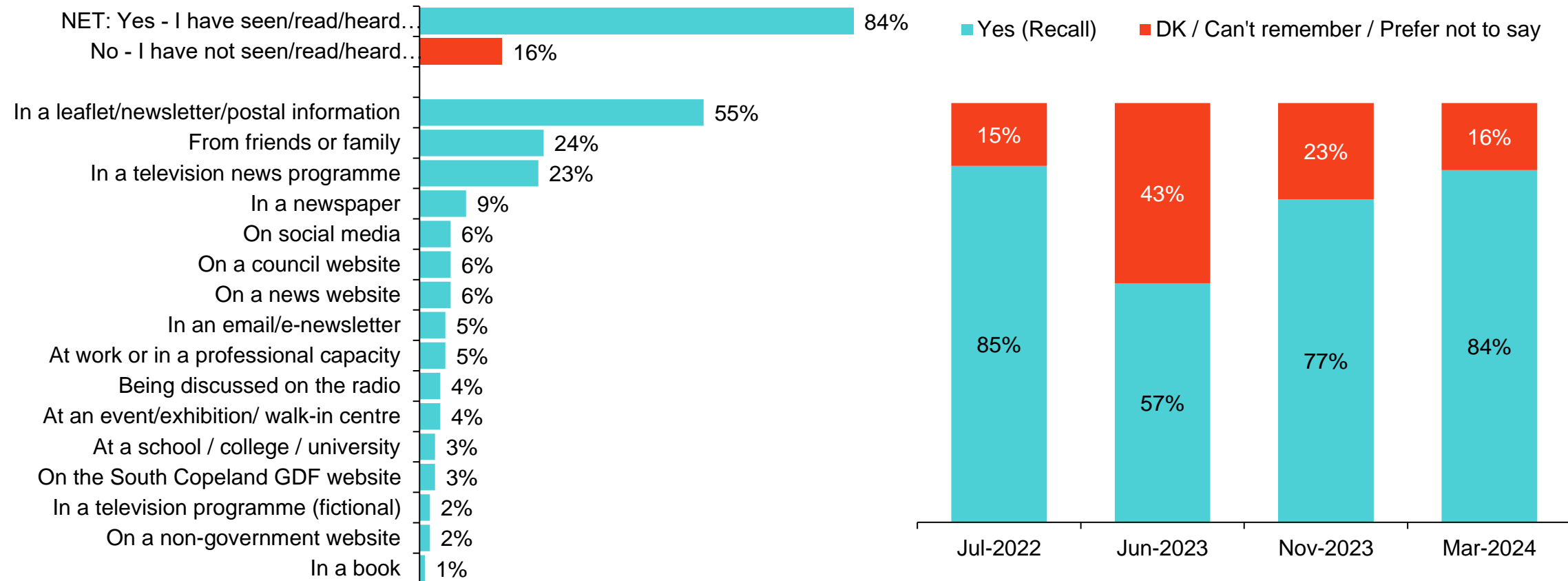
With a sample of 201 and a 95% confidence interval, a margin of error of +/-7% is expected (though confidence intervals do vary depending on the values involved).

# 84% recalled seeing, reading, or hearing something in the past year. 55% attributed their awareness to a leaflet or newsletter

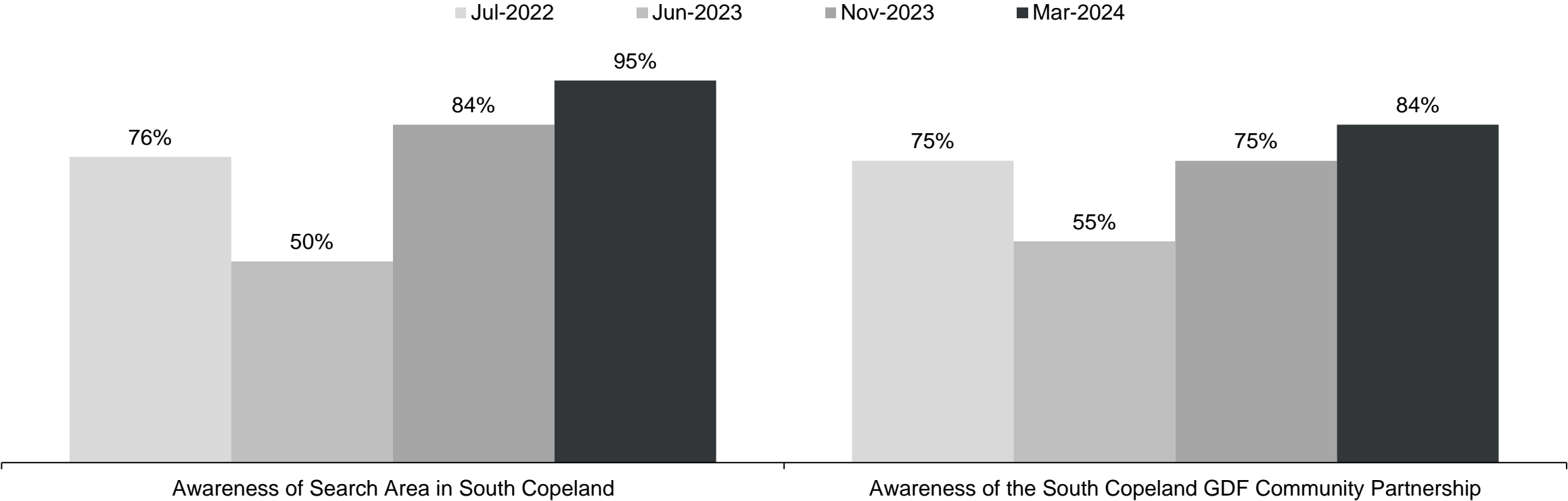

Q. Before today, were you aware or unaware of the following?

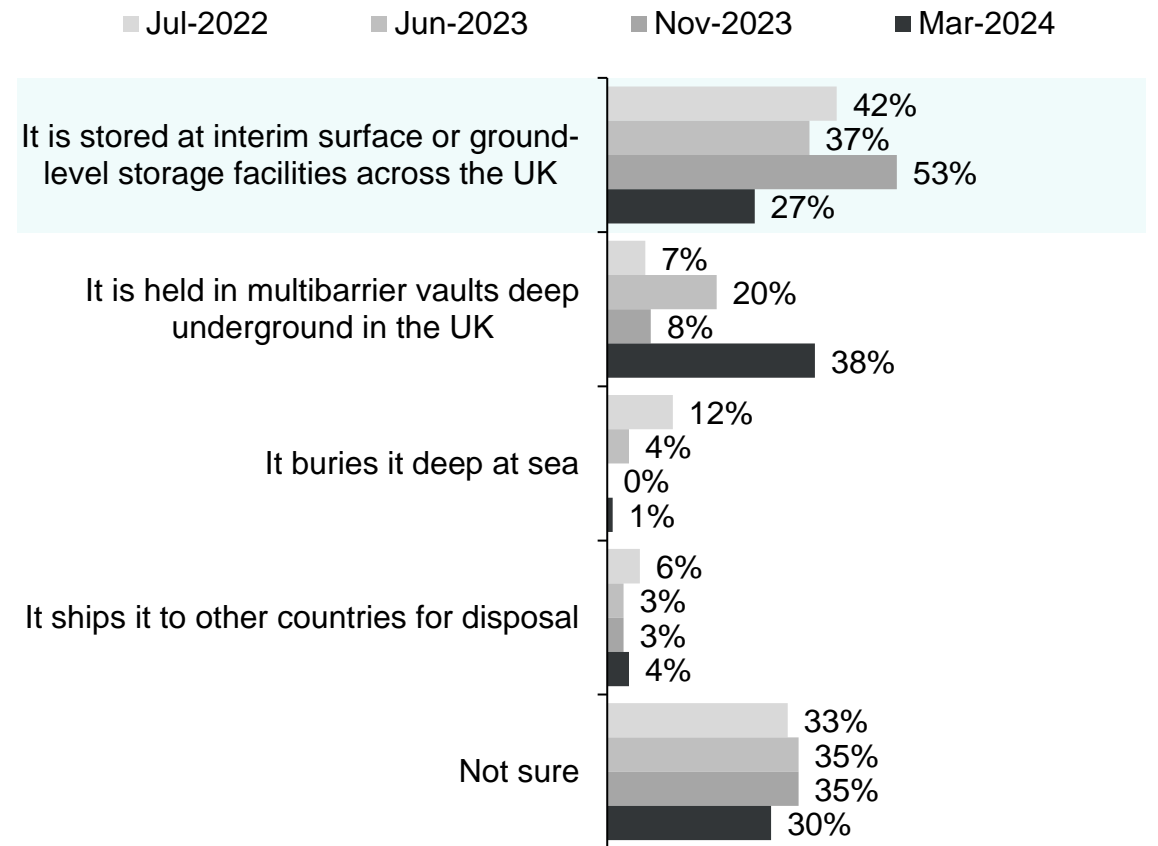
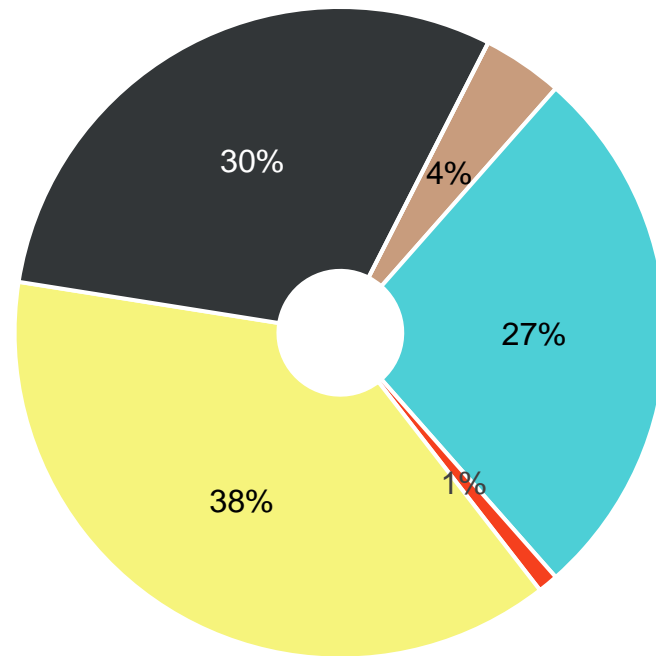
[% of respondents saying they were aware]

Q. What best describes your understanding of how the UK currently manages, stores or disposes of its higher activity radioactive waste – the most radioactive of waste?

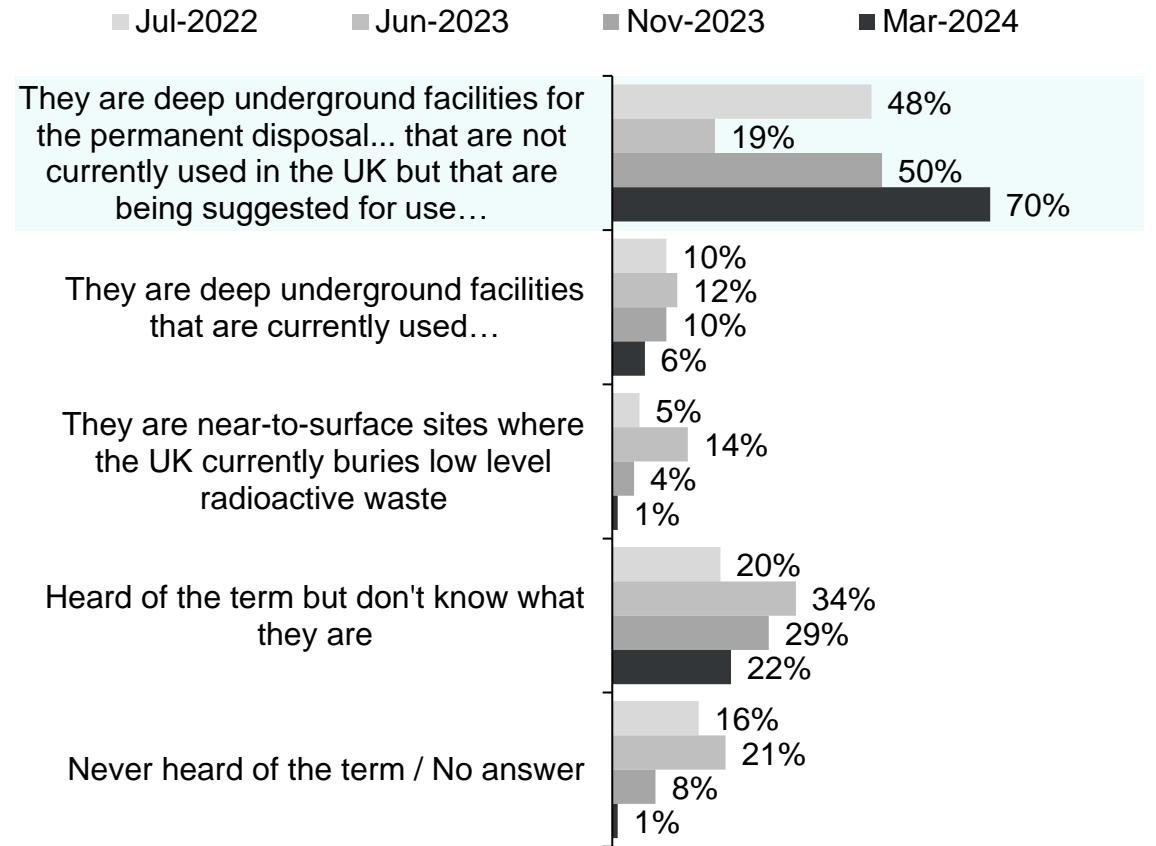
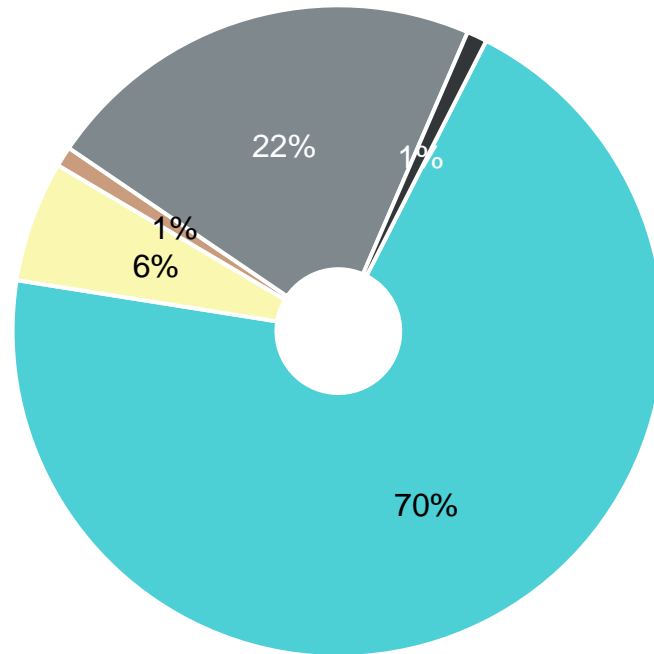
- It ships it to other countries for disposal

# 70% were able to identify the accurate description of a GDF

- Never heard of the term



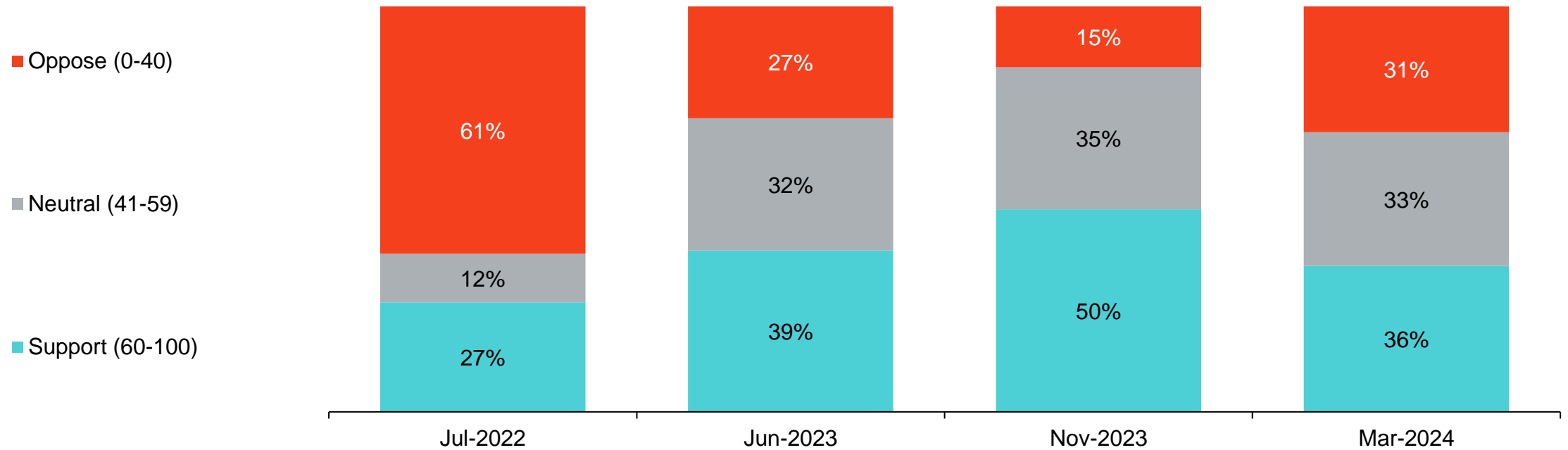

# 36% supported a GDF in the Search Area, whilst 31% opposed it. One-in-three remained neutral

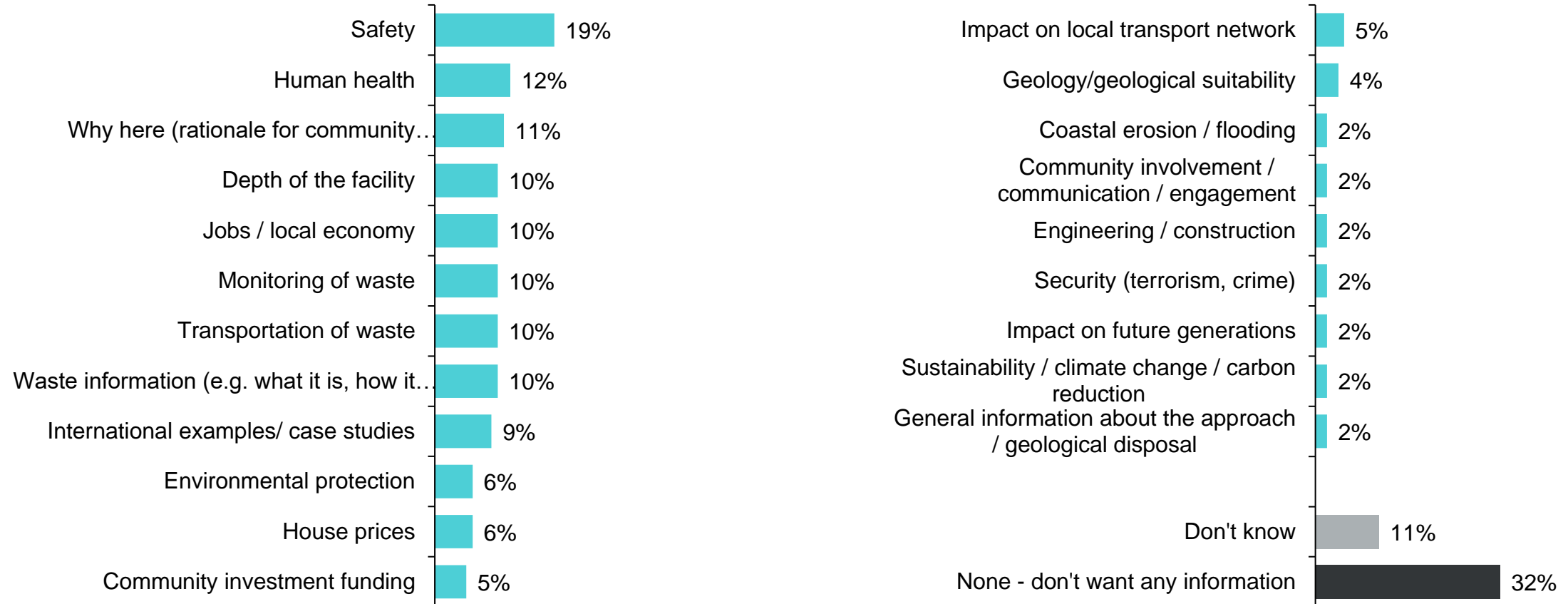

Q. What kind of information would you like to receive regarding geological disposal and the siting process?\*



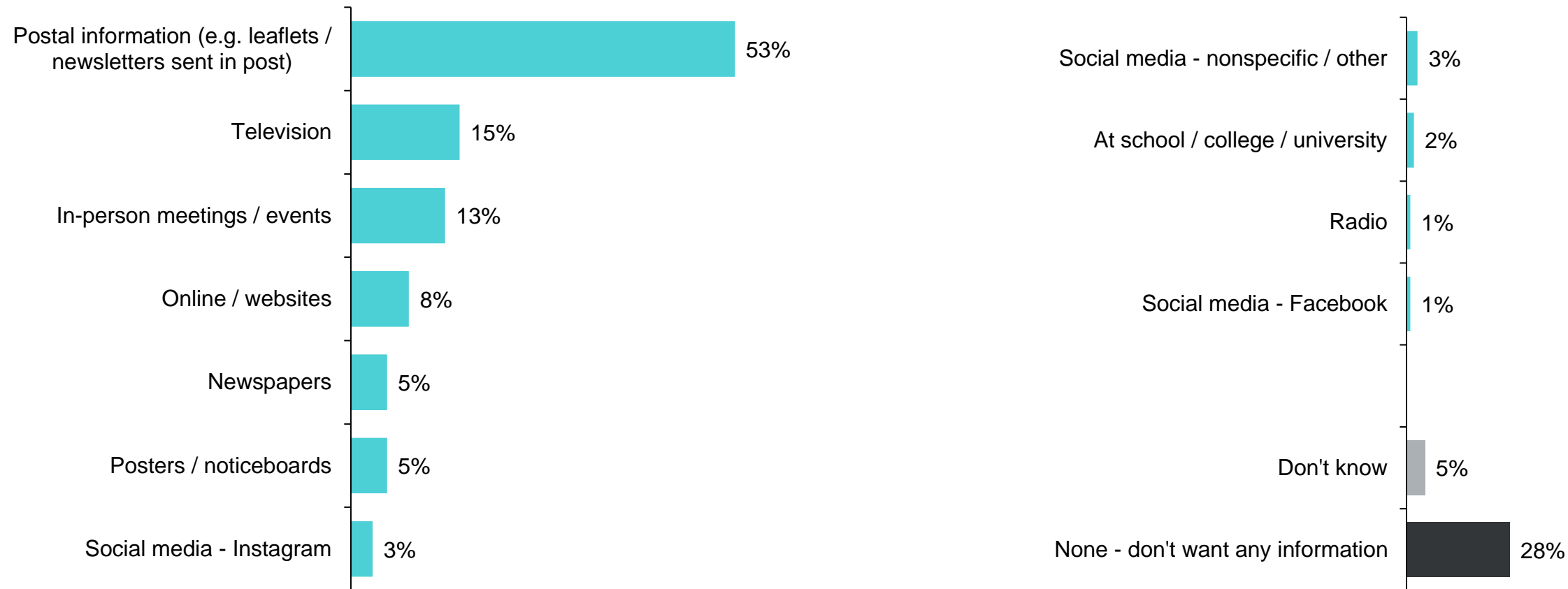

Q. How would you like to receive information about geological disposal and the siting process?\*



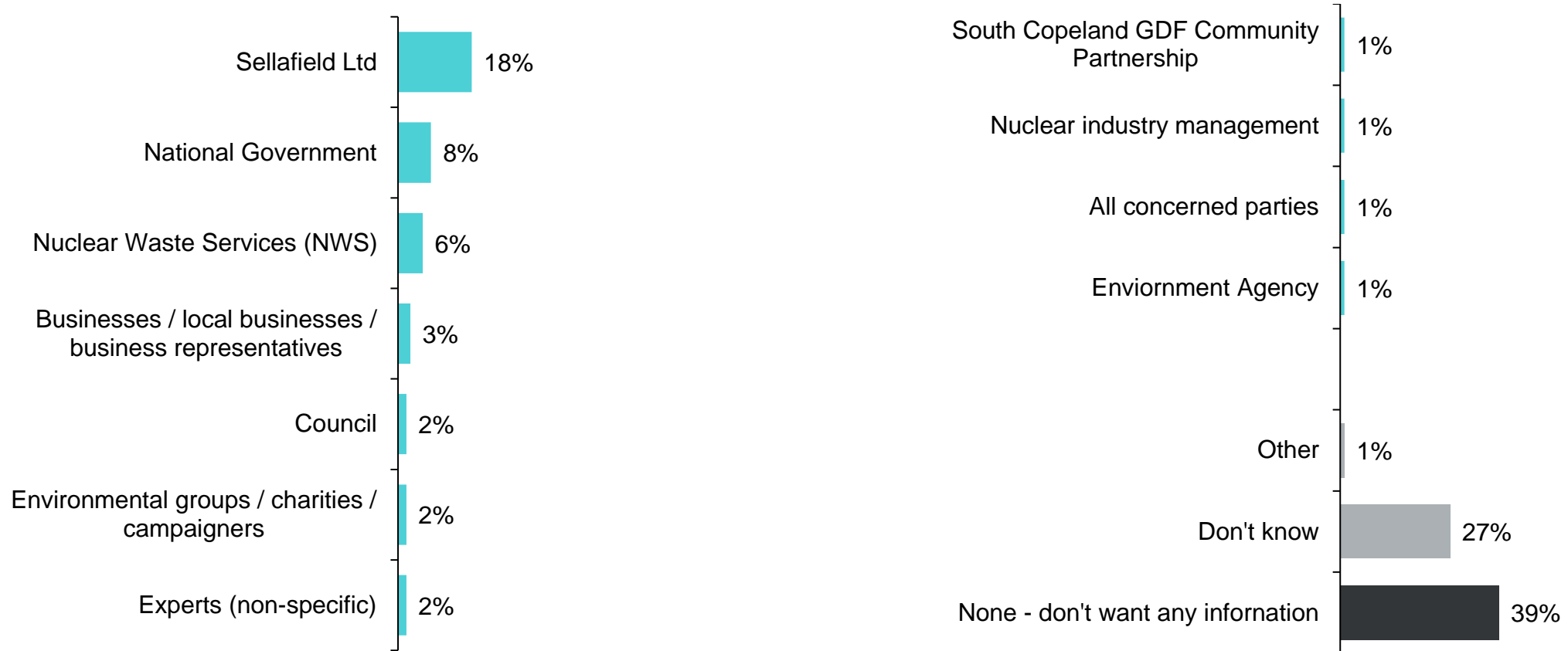
